Each year NSCS awards 50 **Merit Awards** to outstanding new members around the country. This prestigious award includes a \$1,000 scholarship to help defray the costs of education.

Merit Award recipients are selected based on how they exemplify the NSCS mission to "Honor and inspire academic excellence and engaged citizenship for a lifetime."

Integrity Scholarship

In conjunction with the National Leadership Council's ongoing academic integrity initiative, NSCS has created a new INTEGRITY Scholarship for members. Proceeds from the sale of INTEGRITY wristbands will contribute to this scholarship fund.

NSCS will award three \$1,000 scholarships, one each to three members who demonstrate a true commitment to academic integrity through a series of short answer questions describing a time when their integrity has been challenged.

Study Abroad Scholarship

The NSCS Scholar Abroad scholarship program funds one \$5,000 award each fall and spring semester and one \$2,500 award each summer. Applications for the scholarship should be submitted online by the designated deadline dates online.

Scholar at Sea

NSCS and the Semester at Sea program are pleased to offer the **Scholar at Sea** scholarship allowing students to visit nearly a dozen countries while studying on a sailing campus. The University of Virginia academically sponsors this program and grants credit from more than 70 courses.

Seven partial scholarships are provided each year. One \$7,000 partial scholarship is awarded for each fall and spring voyage and five \$2,000 scholarships are awarded for the summer voyage. To find out more about Semester at Sea, please visit www.semesteratsea.com.

NSCS- Geico Graduate Scholarships

Four \$5,000 graduate school scholarships. NSCS has partnered with GEICO to offer four scholarships annually to deserving, talented, and motivated NSCS members who are continuing their education.



To be eligible for this scholarship, NSCS members must be accepted into and entering a graduate or Ph.D. degree seeking program in the fall following the application period. Students enrolling in professional programs such as medical school or law school are also eligible to apply.

Geico Achievement Award

NSCS members are now eligible to apply for GEICO's 2007 Achievement Award. This \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded to one outstanding sophomore or junior to help offset the cost of his/her undergraduate education.

NSCS members must meet the following criteria in order to apply:

- Current sophomore or junior
- Current cumulative GPA of at least a 3.0
- Declared major in one of the following (or similar) fields:
 - Accounting, Actuarial Science, Administration, Advertising, Business,
 Communications, Computer Science, Criminal Justice, Economics, Finance,
 Human Resources, Information Science, Management, Marketing,
 Mathematics, Psychology, Public Relations, Risk Management, and Sociology
- Involvement in the campus and/or local community
- Financial Need

Grand Canyon Semester

NSCS members will earn credits in a variety of subjects while exploring wilderness areas, attending lectures, hiking backcountry trails, visiting archaeological sites, and rafting the Colorado River. The Grand Canyon Semester waives the \$300 class fee for course PRM 398 exclusively for NSCS members.
